WHEREAS, defendant, in view of failure of plaintiff or his counsel to appear, moved for the dismissal of this case for failure to prosecute.

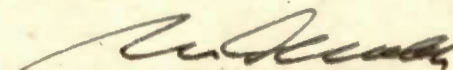
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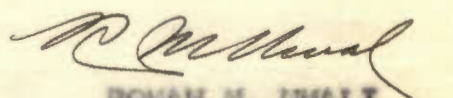
WHEREFORE, for failure of plaintiff or his
