O R D E R

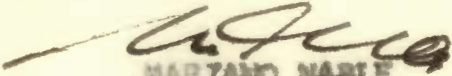

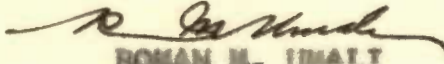
WHEREFORE, there being no opposition interposed by the respondent and/or his counsel, and for the reasons stated in the "Motion to Dismiss";
