As agreed upon by the parties, the Court proceeded to read the dispositive portion of the decision which states:

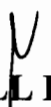

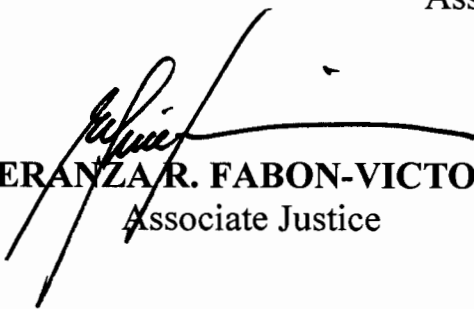
