RESOLUTION

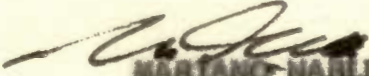
This is in connection with petitioner's "Motion to Dismiss" to which respondent interposed no objection.

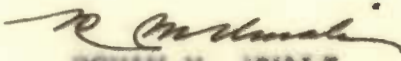
