“Manifestation” that the Secretary of Justice issued on June 4, 2009 a Resolution reversing and setting aside the Resolution, dated December 15, 2008, issued by State Pros. Bernardo L. 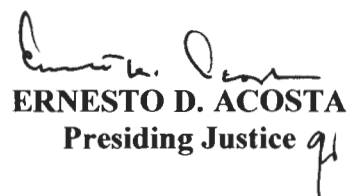

Consequently, the bail bonds posted in cash for the provisional liberty of all accused are hereby **CANCELLED AND ORDERED RELEASED** to all the accused.
