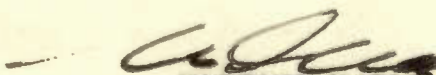

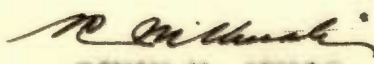

AS PRAYED FOR, the petition for review in this case filed on June 3, 1959 is hereby dismissed without pronouncement as to costs.

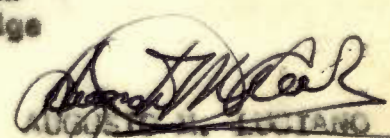
