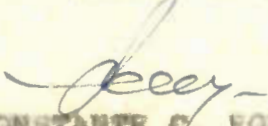
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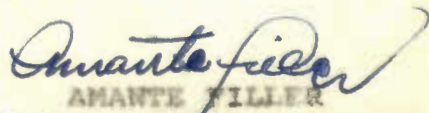
R E S O L U T I O N

Considering that in its Resolution dated December 19, 1977, this Court, in granting petitioner's motion for reconsideration setting aside its Order of February 3, 1977 dismissing this case for lack of interest of petitioner to prosecute its appeal, set this case for hearing with the warning to petitioner's counsel that no further postponement will be allowed; but despite said warning, petitioner's counsel again failed to appear in the scheduled hearing on August 2 and 3, 1978, thus clearly demonstrating not only his apparent unconcern for the early disposition of this case which, as the records show, has been pending since 1973, but also his utter lack of interest to prosecute petitioner's appeal, the Court, upon motion of respondent's counsel, and on its own initiative, resolves to DISMISS and terminate this case.
