R E S O L U T I O N

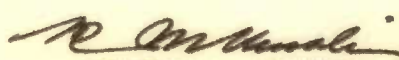
The petitioner filed, on June 20, 1960, a "Motion to Withdraw Petition for Review", alleging that this case was filed on the basis of the principle laid down in the decision of this Court in the case of Mariano R. Lacson vs. Collector of Internal Revenue, C.T.A. Case No. 302, promulgated on September 2, 1957; that the hearing of the instant case was postponed to await the final adjudication of the aforesaid case which was appealed to the Supreme Court by the Collector of Internal Revenue; and that on April 29, 1960, the Supreme Court, in G.R. No. L-12945, reversed our decision in the aforesaid case. The motion now under consideration was filed with the conformity of counsel for respondent.

WHEREFORE, the motion to withdraw the petition for review is hereby granted, without pronouncement as to costs.
