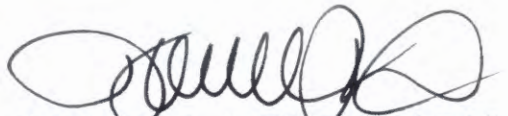
Records show that, as of October 11, 2019,¹ plaintiff has failed to comply with the aforesaid Resolution of the Court.

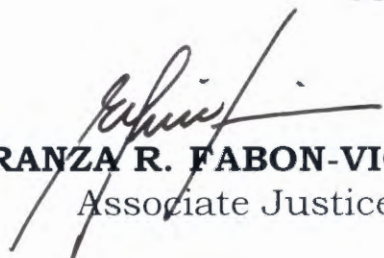
WHEREFORE, considering plaintiff's failure to comply with this Court's Resolution dated August 22, 2019, which will establish the personal identity and personal circumstances of the accused, Roland P. Vasquez, under Section 4 of Rule 110 of the Revised Rules of Criminal Procedure, and considering

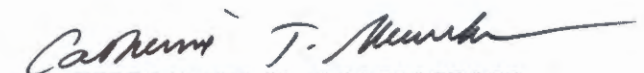

further, that in case the criminal offender is a corporation, the penalty shall be imposed on the Partner, **President**, General Manager, et.al., responsible for the violation under Section 253 (d) of the 1997 National Internal Revenue Code (NIRC), as amended, Criminal Case No. O-713 is hereby **DISMISSED** for lack of probable cause.
