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R E S O L U T I O N

In a Resolution dated July 10, 2019, plaintiff was given five (5) days from receipt of notice to submit clear photocopies of the following:

- a. Assessment Notices issued against Great Domestic indicating clearly the taxable period/periods involved and the type of taxes referred to; and
- b. Amended General Information Sheet filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC).

In that same Resolution, plaintiff was also directed to make the necessary clarification on the Information with regard to the identification of one of the accused included in the Information – “Marcelesa Sarto” or “Marcelisa Sarto”, also within five (5) days from notice.

Records show that, as of July 31, 2019,¹ plaintiff has failed to comply with the Resolution of this Court, dated July 10, 2019.

WHEREFORE, considering plaintiff's failure to comply with this Court's Resolution dated July 10, 2019, Criminal Case No. O-741 is hereby **DISMISSED**.
