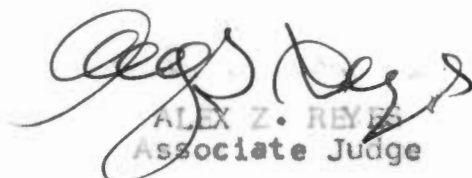

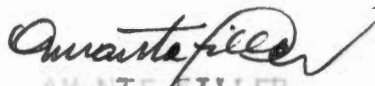
R E S O L U T I O N

Considering that this case had been previously dismissed by the Court for lack of interest on the part of petitioner's counsel to prosecute his appeal in its resolution of June 20, 1986, although the dismissal was reconsidered by the Court in a resolution dated November 26, 1986 with stern warning that a similar omission or default on the part of petitioner will not be excused (see p. 55, C.T.A. rec.), and considering the non-appearance again of petitioner's counsel at the scheduled hearing on March 11, 1987 despite proper notice thereof, evincing disrespect to judicial proceedings and dignity of the Court, this Court, upon motion of respondent, hereby orders the dismissal of the above-entitled case for lack of interest on the part of petitioner to prosecute its appeal.
