In view of the "Compliance" (or written manifestation) filed by respondent Commissioner of Internal Revenue on July 12, 1982, stating as follows:

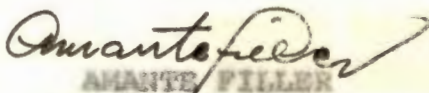

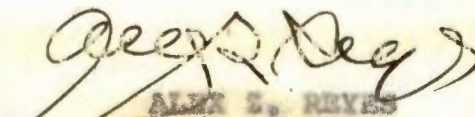
Respondent, therefore, interposes no objection if this case will be considered closed and terminated."

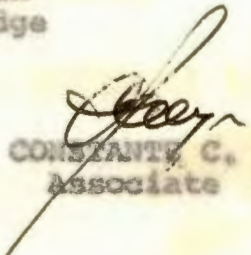
the Court resolves to consider the above-entitled case closed and terminated.
