R E S O L U T I O N

Petitioner, as surety of Andres E. Lazaro, claimant of various merchandise described in seizure identification Nos. 1904 and 1905, has appealed to this Court seeking the reversal of the decision of respondent, dated September 10, 1963, claiming that the said decision is null and void. Respondent filed A "Motion To Dismiss" on December 20, 1963, alleging that the petition was filed beyond the thirty-day period prescribed by Republic Act No. 1125, and that petitioner has no cause of action against the respondent.

On January 6, 1964, petitioner filed a motion for leave to file opposition and on January 17, 1964, a motion to extend the time to file opposition.

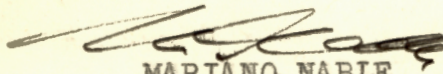
For failure of petitioner to appear before the Court on January 18, 1964, the "Motion For Leave To File Opposition" was denied and the "Motion To Dismiss" was granted.

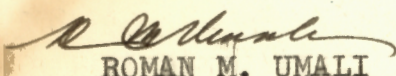
