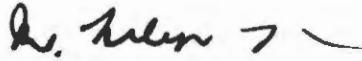
RESOLUTION

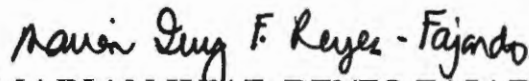
