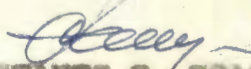
O R D E R

Considering the reason alleged by petitioner's counsel in his "Motion To Dismiss" filed on December 9, 1976, that the subject matter of this appeal, involving the 65 sacks of coffee beans which were declared forfeited by the Bureau of Customs, were burned with the RASAC warehouse in Jolo, Sulu, on February 8, 1974 during a conflagration resulting from the battle between the Government forces and the rebels, and that the loss thereof has rendered the issues raised by the parties in this case already academic and for lack of objection on the part of respondent's counsel, the said motion is hereby GRANTED.
