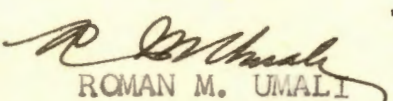
In the hearing of said "Motion to Dismiss", the respondent Collector (now Commissioner) of Internal Revenue did not interpose any objection thereto.

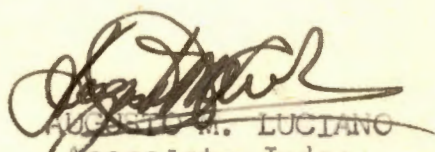
WHEREFORE, let this case be, as it is hereby, dismissed, without pronouncement as to costs.
