On September 27, 1971, during the hearing of this

case be held in abeyance pending receipt by this Court
of a copy of the memorandum of the Appellate Division
of the Bureau of Internal Revenue recommending the
refund or tax credit of the sum of ₱16,533.66 being
claimed by the Testate Estate of the late Don Roman
R. Santos. It was also ordered that respondent submit
within ten days a copy of the order of respondent
granting refund or tax credit in favor of the Estate
of the said sum of ₱16,533.66. On the same date,
counsel for respondent submitted one additional folder
of BIR records consisting of 106 pages, containing a
copy of the order granting the tax credit.

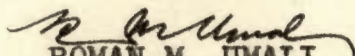

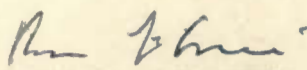
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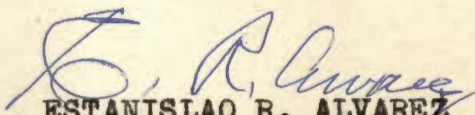
IN VIEW OF THE FOREGOING, the above-entitled
