RESOLUTION

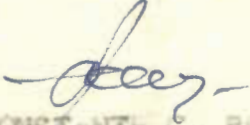

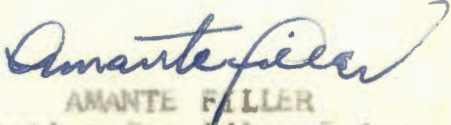
The Court resolved, as prayed for, to grant petitioner's motion to dismiss.
