RESOLUTION

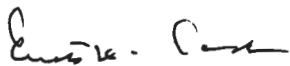
During the hearing held on October 14, 2011, the representative of petitioner (who has no counsel) and respondent's counsel (notified) failed to appear.

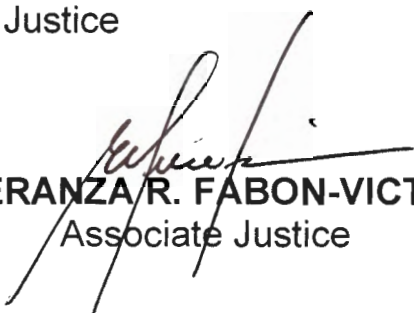
