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RESOLUTION

On December 5, 2022, an Information was filed against accused Jian Min Wang indicting him of violation of Section 130, in relation to Section 255, paragraph 1 of the National Internal Revenue Code (NIRC) of 1997, as amended. However, the Court observes that in the caption of the case, the name of the accused is **JIAN MIN WANG** while in the body of the Information, the name is **JIAN MING WANG**.

WHEREFORE, the prosecution is **DIRECTED** to clarify the discrepancy in the name of the accused and make the necessary amendment to the Information within **five (5)** days from notice.

Upon receipt of the foregoing or lapse of the period provided, the Court shall act accordingly.
