RESOLUTION

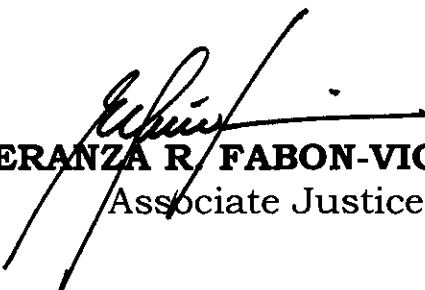
Records further show that as of June 26, 2020,¹ plaintiff failed to comply with the Resolution of the Court.
