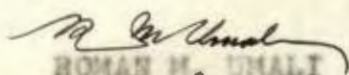
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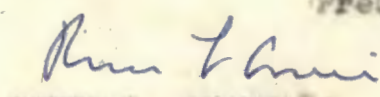
R E S O L U T I O N

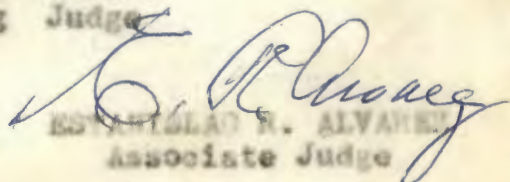
Considering petitioners' motion for withdrawal of
