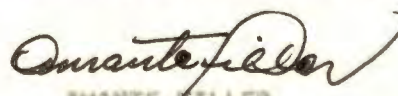
R E S O L U T I O N

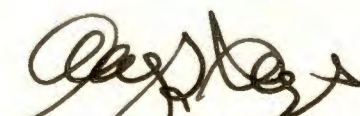
Considering that this case had been previously dismissed by the Court for lack of interest on the part of petitioner to prosecute its appeal during the hearing on March 12, 1985 and confirmed in our resolution of March 19, 1985, although the dismissal was reconsidered by the Court in a resolution dated October 28, 1985 with a warning that no further postponement will be allowed, more postponements thereafter upon the request of counsel for petitioner, pendency of this case since April 16, 1984; and considering further the non-appearance of counsel for petitioner at the scheduled hearing on October 28, 1988 despite proper notice thereof, evincing disrespect to the dignity of judicial proceedings, this Court, upon motion of respondent in open court, resolves to dismiss the above-entitled case with prejudice for lack of interest on the part of petitioner to prosecute its appeal.
