Considering that this case had been previously dismissed twice by the Court for lack of interest on the part of petitioner's counsel to prosecute his appeal in its resolutions of October 11, 1984 and September 30, 1985 (Pp. 47 and 62, CTA rec.), although the dismissals were reconsidered by the Court in our resolutions dated January 23, 1985 and May 26, 1986 (Pp. 53 and 77, CTA rec.), with stern warning that a similar omission or default on the part of petitioner will not be allowed, and considering further the non-appearance again for the third time of petitioner's counsel at the scheduled hearing on November 26, 1986 despite proper notice thereof, evincing disrespect to the dignity of judicial proceedings, this Court, upon motion of respondent, hereby orders the dismissal of the above-entitled case with prejudice for lack of interest on the part

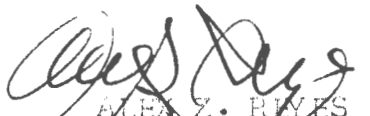
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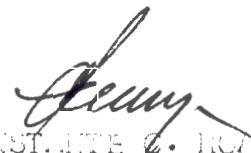
