RESOLUTION

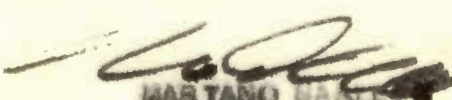

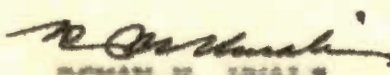
Both parties did not appear on the date set for the consideration of this motion.

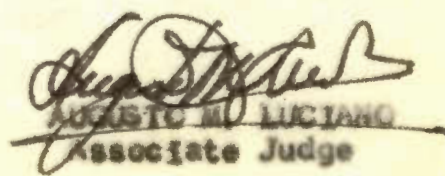
