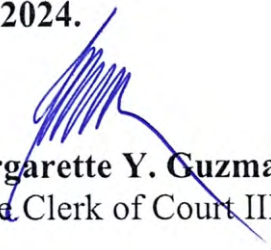

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RESOLUTION

On January 22, 2024, petitioner filed a *Motion to Withdraw Petition for Review* (Re: CTA Case No. 11135), praying that the instant *Petition for Review*, relative to CTA Case No. 11135, be *withdrawn* on the ground that its administrative claim for refund in the *total* amount of Php1,488,454,886.83, arising from the erroneous payment of excise taxes, which includes the subject of CTA Case No. 11135, had been *granted* by the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR). However, petitioner manifested that it intends to continue litigating CTA Case No. 11055.

There being *no objection* on the part of respondent Commissioner of Internal Revenue, the Court resolves to grant petitioner's *Motion to Withdraw Petition for Review* in CTA Case No. 11135 and to continue the proceedings in CTA Case No. 11055.

WHEREFORE, the *Petition for Review* docketed as CTA Case No. 11135 is **WITHDRAWN**. Accordingly, CTA Case No. 11135 is deemed **CLOSED** and **TERMINATED**.

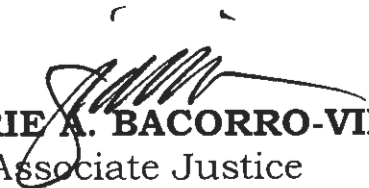
