RESOLUTION

Arellano, to submit, within FIVE (5) DAYS, the original or certified true copies of the original of the Records of the Preliminary Investigation, such as the Counter Affidavit of the accused, Subpoenas issued by the investigating officer, and Minutes of the Hearings Conducted.
