Petitioner BANGSAMORO FEDERALIST PARTY - YOUTH SECTORAL WING, represented by its President, TOMANDA, through the undersigned counsel, unto this Honorable Commission, most respectfully manifests that:

I. TIMELINESS

1. The Guidelines of the Honorable Commission, which requires the submission of Petition of Certification as Regional Parliamentary Political Party - Youth Sectoral Wing is until April 7, 2026. Thus, this petition is filed in a timely manner.

II. INTRODUCTORY STATEMENT

2. This Petition is respectfully filed seeking the accreditation of BANGSAMORO FEDERALIST PARTY - YOUTH SECTORAL WING (hereinafter referred to by its acronym "BFP-YSW") as a Parliamentary Sectoral Wing of a Regional

Parliamentary Political Party pursuant to applicable election laws and Bangsamoro issuances.

3. Moreover, BFP-YSW was already certified by the Bangsamoro Youth Commission (BYC) as evidenced by herein attached *Certification* dated 6 April 2026 and marked as **Annex "A"**.
4. The official logo of the BFP-YSW, showing its images, words, colors, and markings used to symbolize its ideals and principles, is attached as **Annex "B"**;

III. PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND CONTACT DETAILS

5. The principal place of business of the BFP-YSW is located at Barangay Tamontaka Mother, Cotabato City, Maguindanao del Norte, BARMM;

9. The BFP-YSW was organized and established on March 7, 2026, at Grand Regal Hotel & Casino, Davao City, by its founders who are citizens of the Republic of the Philippines, residents, and registered voters of BARMM;

13. The BFP-YSW has at least fifty (50) members belonging to the youth sector who are registered voters within BARMM;

14. The BFP-YSW is committed to advancing a people-centered, inclusive, and youth-empowered governance agenda.
15. It recognizes the youth as vital partners in peacebuilding, leadership, and sustainable development.
16. Its programs of government, platform, policies, and principles are attached as Annex "G";

VIII. DECLARATIONS

1. The BFP-WSW is not a religious sect or denomination and represents the women sector regardless of religious affiliation;
2. It shall pursue its goals through lawful means and uphold the 1987 Constitution and all applicable laws;
3. The BFP-WSW does not receive financial support or contributions from any national political party and/or any foreign government or entity, nor does it maintain alliances with such parties for purposes of parliamentary participation;

IX. PARTICIPATION IN ELECTIONS

4. The BFP-WSW intends to participate in the Parliamentary Sectoral Representative Elections. Its Manifestation of Intent to Participate (MIP-PSRS) in the 2026 Bangsamoro Elections is attached as Annex "H";
5. The List of Nominees of the BFP-WSW, together with their respective Certificates of Acceptance of Nomination for Sectoral Candidacy (CAN-SC), duly accomplished in the form prescribed by the Commission, is hereto attached as Annex "I" respectively;

X. PAYMENT OF THE REQUIRED DOCKET FEES

6. In compliance with Comelec Resolution No. 11203 and for purposes of the filing of this petition for accreditation, the required docket fees are paid as evidenced by the Official Receipt issued to that effect which is herein attached and marked as Annex "J";

XI. COMPLIANCE WITH THE PUBLICATION REQUIREMENT

7. Section 119 (h) of Comelec Resolution 11203 requires the publication of the Petition for Accreditation, the MIP-PLRS and the List of Nominees in a newspaper of general or regional circulation or the Bangsamoro Official Gazette.
8. In compliance with the aforesaid section, petitioner has faithfully complied with the same as evidenced by herein attached *Affidavit of Publication* dated 07 APR 2026 and marked as Annex "K".

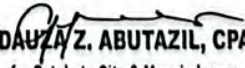
